When you finish, I hope it is full!



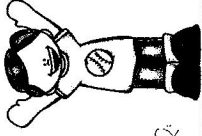
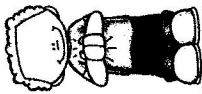
Language Activity:

First, listen closely to this story.



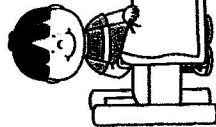
When you hear a character's name, clap 3x.

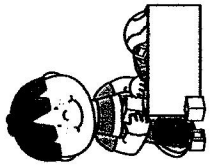
Next, retell the story using the targeted word ("first", "next", "then", "last") and the provided picture scene. Complete the suggested exercise before moving on to the next circle.

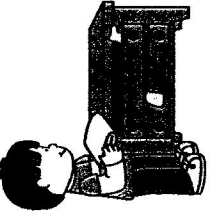
HOP ON ONE FOOT 3X

Next...



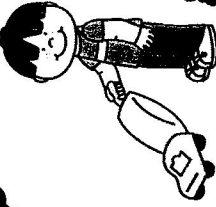
SPIN AROUND 3X
